Ideally a Level 2 QCF in Health Care or equivalent qualification with evidence of further training in Autistic Spectrum Condition. 3. In depth working knowledge and understanding of Autism Spectrum Conditions and disability issues in the context of working in Jersey. A background which demonstrates assessment and the ability to devise action plans to develop life and social skills. 4. The ability to ensure that vulnerable people are safe in the working environment and have an in depth understanding of safeguarding policies and procedures. 5. The ability to communicate with vulnerable people and supervise work sessions with a balance of care and control. 6. The capacity to work under their own initiative and take responsibility for the effective organisation of work. 7. To provide a reliable and consistent commitment to the aims and objectives of Autism Jersey. 8. To have a good understanding of the need for confidentiality in relation to all aspects of Autism Jersey and partner agencies. 9.
