These roles will be ideally suited for an employee currently working on a Zero Hour Contract, or less than 30 Hours per week who is looking to commit to more hours per week. 2. Sleep-Ins may be required. 3. Knowledge of and/or further training in Autistic Spectrum Condition & challenging behaviour coupled with at least 2-3 years' previous support experience is desirable. 4. Ideally a Level 2 QCF in Health Care or equivalent qualification coupled with Conflict Management training (e.g. Maybo). 5. In depth working knowledge and understanding of disability issues in the context of working in Jersey. 6. The ability to devise action plans to develop life and social skills. 7. The ability to ensure that vulnerable people are safe in the working environment and have an in depth understanding of safeguarding policies and procedures. 8. The ability to communicate with vulnerable people and supervise work sessions with a balance of care and control. 9. The capacity to work under their own initiative and take responsibility for the effective organisation of work. 10. To provide a reliable and consistent commitment to the aims and objectives of Autism Jersey. 11. To have a good understanding of the need for confidentiality in
