We require a highly motivated and flexible Support Worker to work as a member of the Autism Jersey team providing support for individuals with autism. 2. Ideally a Level 2 QCF/RQF in Health & Social Care or equivalent qualification or willing to work towards this. 3. The successful candidate will assist in the planning, preparation and delivery of services for clients with Autism Spectrum Conditions. 4. The role requires the ability to work across all service projects on a flexible basis and to fulfil the relevant requirements around sleep-ins. 5. Full-time on a 37.5 Hour per week basis, based on a 2 week rolling rota, and may include evening work &/sleep-ins. 6. A good standard of education together with knowledge and understanding of Autism Spectrum Conditions and disability issues are required. 7. The ability to ensure that vulnerable people are safe in the working environment and have an in depth understanding of safeguarding policies and procedures. 8. The ability to communicate with vulnerable people and supervise work sessions with a balance of care and control. 9. The capacity to work under their own initiative and take responsibility for the effective organisation of work. 10. To provide a reliable and consistent commitment to the aims and objectives of Autism Jersey. 11. To have a good understanding of the need for confidentiality in relation to all aspects of Autism Jersey and partner agencies. 12. To have an understanding and empathy with clients and the ability to listen and provide appropriate guidance. 13. To respond to problems in a calm and pragmatic way. 14. To think 'outside the box' and be creative with ideas.
